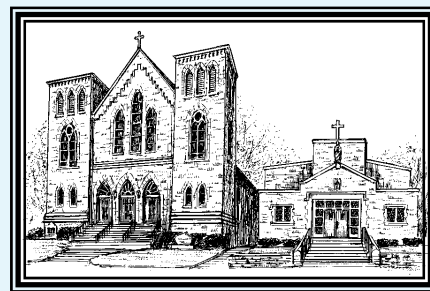

As each person shares this bread, they are asked to forgive any hurts that may have occurred over the past year and to wish the person all possible health and happiness in the coming year.

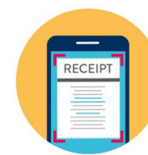
## GENERAL MILLS BOXTOPS FOR EDUCATION
