


A <u>Centering Prayer Introductory Session</u> lead by Nancy Cord-Baran will be offered on Saturday, February 22, 2025, from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm, at St. John's Rectory in the basement meeting room. Anyone interested in learning about this silent method of prayer and those interested in refreshing their Centering Prayer practice are invited to attend.

Centering prayer is a receptive method of silent prayer that prepares us to receive the gift of contemplative prayer in which we experience God's presence within us, closer than thinking, closer than consciousness itself. This method of prayer is both a relationship with God and a discipline to foster the relationship. Centering prayer is not meant to replace other kinds of prayer. Rather it adds depth and meaning to all prayer and is a receptive prayer of resting in God. Centering Prayer emphasizes prayer as a personal relationship with God and as a movement beyond conversation with God to communion with Christ.


