### FASTING AND ABSTINENCE DURING LENT

**Ash Wednesday** and **Good Friday** are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, **Fridays** during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence.

**Abstinence = No meat.** Starting at age 14 with no upper age limit.

**Fasting** = a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals.

A person 59 and beyond may choose to participate to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, if health permits.
