**KINDERGARTEN and PRE-K REGISTRATION
FOR 2020-2021**

Registration forms can be found online at www.saintjohnsch.net.

Children must be five years old before September 1, 2020, to be eligible for Kindergarten. We will need copies of birth certificate, baptismal certificate and immunization records, as well as a \$100 non-refundable fee to register. Since school buildings are currently closed, please email sjadmin@saintjohnsch.net ..

Children must be three or four years old before September 1, 2020, to be eligible for our three-year-old and four-year-old Pre-K Program, respectively. Students currently enrolled in the three-year-old Pre-K must re-register for the four-year-old class. You will need copies of birth certificate and immunization records, as well as a \$100 non-refundable fee to register. Since school buildings are currently closed, please email www.saintjohnsch.net.
