Because of the seriousness of this flu season, Bishop Bartchak has asked that the Precious Blood of the Lord not be offered at Mass temporarily. It is the belief of the Catholic Church that the whole Body of Christ is present under either form of consecrated bread and wine. Also, the exchange of the sign of peace should avoid bodily contact. A reverent nod with eye contact and a smile will be the temporary practice. Reception of Holy Communion on the hand is encouraged; however, reception on the tongue may not be denied. These norms are in effect throughout the winter months or until the flu season is over.

ST. JOHN PILGRIMAGE – On Thursday, May 9, St. John the Evangelist in Bellefonte will be taking a pilgrimage to the National Centre for Padre Pio, in Barto, PA. Padre Pio is the first priest in history to bear the wounds of Christ. The National Centre for Padre Pio has been recognized by the Holy See for its spiritual work. There will be plenty of time to visit the Museum and Cultural Center, Our Lady of Grace Chapel and Gift Shop. We will also be stopping at the Biblical Tabernacle Reproduction in Lancaster. There you will be guided on a 45 minute lecture tour on the Ark of the Covenant in the Holy of Holies. Fullington Bus will pick up at 9:00 am in front of St. John's, Bellefonte. Trip cost is \$115.00 per person which includes admission fees and supper at the Shady Maple Smorgasbord in Lancaster. Lunch is additional. Call the rectory at St. John's 355-3134 to reserve a spot.
